CONCLUSIONS OF LAW UNDER SEAL**

The defendant filed a response and proposed order to the motion to seal, not opposing the motion to seal. While not as clear, it appears the defendants also agree that the TRO request is now in fact proceeding as a preliminary injunction, mooting the pending motion to convert the TRO request to a preliminary injunction.

Finally, the defendant also correctly points out the their Rule 17 is not mooted by the preliminary injunction hearings, nor did the plaintiff intend to suggest otherwise.

Thus, the order submitted by the defendants is acceptable to the plaintiff, subject to the clarification that this matter is now being treated as a request for a preliminary injunction.
