HAMED MOTION TO SPECIAL MASTER ROSS FOR AN ORDER AS TO CLAIMS ALREADY ADDRESSED "NUMBER 3"

I. Introduction

On October 4, 2019, Hamed filed a notice of withdrawal of three claims and one pending motion for summary judgment. On October 8, 2019, the Court entered an order granting that withdrawal.

ORDERED that Hamed Claim Nos. H-34, H-58, and H-85 shall be withdrawn with prejudice and are hereby STRICKEN WITH PREJUDICE. And it is further:

ORDERED that Hamed's motion for summary judgment regarding Hamed Claim No. H-34 shall be withdrawn with prejudice and is hereby STRICKEN WITH PREJUDICE.

That Order has been referred to as "Order as to Claims Already Addressed Number 1."

The parties then jointly sought the Master's permission to create a similar mechanism for having the Court provide formal orders for other claims which the parties may dispose of by withdrawal, compromise or concession. They stated that "this will provide a running record in the docket as to the status of all claims—and at the end of the review process, an easy to use summary of the disposal of all claims, for the calculation of offsetting amounts."

They proposed to submit these from time to time, and number them in sequence, using a standardized format. That second motion was submitted to the Master on November 22, 2019, under the caption "JOINT MOTION TO SPECIAL MASTER ROSS FOR ORDER AS TO CLAIMS ALREADY ADDRESSED NUMBER 2." It was granted on November 22, 2019.

This instant motion is the third such request, and comes from Hamed's efforts to streamline the process by removing claims that are too small to be cost-effective to process. It is filed after consultation with opposing counsel as part of the routine process of ongoing telephone conferences to attempt to alleviate the load and deal with issues.

Comes now Hamed, and having fully informed counsel for Yusuf, and moves the Special Master to issue an order disposing of the referenced claims in the manner described in the included ORDER:
