Ross, either in the context of the winding up of the Hamed-Yusuf Partnership in SX-2012-CV-00370, or as a separate referral and appointment limited specifically to the parties and issues in these consolidated matters. The parties shall jointly or separately report to the Court in writing with regard to the results of their conference **not more than 30 days from the date of this Order.**
