THIS MATTER is before the Special Master (hereinafter "Master") sua sponte for review. In an order entered contemporaneously herewith, the Master accepted Hisham Hamed, Sixteen Plus Corporation, Fathi Yusuf, Isam Yousuf, Jamil Yousuf, and Manal Mohammed Yousef's proposed consolidated scheduling order.
